Women of Beaver Valley's Rebirth Begins!

On Tuesday evening, May 14, twenty-one women of the congregation met to begin a conversation about what the future shape and mission of this group will be.

Pastor Greg opened the meeting with a look back at the generations of women who have so faithfully and in so many ways shaped the work of the Church. Their commitment to bible study and a devotional life was the source of their willingness to serve within the congregation and out into the world. From helping serve at funerals and running everything out of the church kitchen to sending handmade quilts around the world through Lutheran World Relief, was



inspired by their commitment to monthly circle bible studies, usually held in the homes of members.

The conversation then shifted to the here and now. **How are we now fed by the word?** In most congregations, the old "circle" groups have gone away or dwindled in number. Good and creative talk surrounded this topic. These questions are worth remembering:

- +How do we find the time and find the right materials for bible study?
- +Could we provide childcare for moms with children who might come to bible study if that service were provided? (youth group support?)
- +Could we get back to using the ELCA women's **Gather magazine** as a source for inspiration across the women's organization?
- +This question rose to the surface, "Could the women get behind new ways to live the devotional life?" (We talked about resources such as the daily, digital devotion that comes to us from Luther Seminary called "God Pause". Several women spoke of this daily devotion as helpful.) What other good tools for spiritual growth are out there that women can use in their own way when time allows? Are there studies that are just one session long instead of a five or six month expected commitment?

Then we talked about **service within the congregation**. Of course, one of the Beaver Valley stories worth remembering is that we serve funeral lunches as well as it can be done: good food provided by members, tables set well, women and men serving those who are needing to feel the love of the congregation. Further conversation will take place about exactly how we use both Parish Life group calling (salads and cakes) as well as the solid lists of names we have from our Time and Talents sheets of those willing to help serve at funeral when needed. Other inside the church topics: care packages, sweet corn feed or produce stand as major fund raiser, support of our own youth.

Then we talked about a host of mission opportunities close to home and around the world. <u>Close to home</u>: Food Sheperds (really under the Evangelism committee but overlaps with women for sure), Children's Inn collections, "Grace our Table" event, Brandon Food Pantry collections, etc. <u>Around the World</u>: Lutheran World Relief layettes and health kit collections; Quilting; Thank offering boxes collected as part of the fall ingathering...often given in support of World Hunger initiatives. Etc.

Finally, talk was held about the importance of a women's leadership team....dividing up duties so that the work is done by many. More talk at the **June 17**th meeting about leadership **structure.** Along this line, more talk about how connected the Beaver Valley women want to be to the existing, synod wide **WELCA organization.**

Please note that the next "all women" meeting will happen on Monday evening, June 17th at 7:00 p.m. in the church fellowship hall.

News from the Outdoor Task Force Committee...

Thank you to Todd Dawley for grinding the last of the tree stumps to get ready for Summer Outdoor Worship!

As we continue to move forward with this project, we are finding that timing is everything! As you read last month, the dead and dying trees have been cleared and work has begun to prepare the site for future planting. Though foundational work will continue, it has become clear to the committee that the smartest and best decision is to delay the planting of the prayer garden project for next spring. We would like to share those reasons with you.

In our contacts with nurseries and landscapers, inventory for our desired plantings is either depleted or very low. In addition, because of labor shortages, most landscapers have full schedules for work through most of the summer.

We need time to assess all the elements hoped for/needed by the church, finalize a plan, and confirm costs.

We need time to bring the vision of the prayer garden before our congregation and raise funds to make it happen! Once the project begins next spring, the bills will come in, and we want to be ready.

There is a lot going on in our church right now. We have yet to physically move back into the church, and it will take time to get settled in. Oh, and there's the matter of looking for a new pastor! The committee feels it might be better to wait until the dust settles from those two major efforts before adding another to the mix.

Just want the church to know that the foundational work continues.

Thank you for letting Nancy find her place within the congregation without pressure. Thank you for laughter and kindness in the hallway in the church where people have walked in and said, "see how these people love one another."
